A Note from the Author

GODfidence was created from a sincere desire to see my sisters and brothers in Christ walk confidently in their true identity. Knowing who we are—and Whose we are—is vital to living a healthy and victorious life.

I have observed that many believers struggle deeply with identity. Too often, insecurity, past wounds, rejection, and comparison distort how we see ourselves. But when we anchor our identity in what God has declared, everything begins to shift.

My prayer is that as these 20 declarations take root in your spirit, you will experience a profound transformation in how you see yourself, how you treat yourself, and how you allow others to treat you.

When identity is settled, confidence follows.

What Is GODfidence?

GODfidence is not confidence in self. It is confidence rooted in God. It is the quiet assurance that who I am is not defined by my past, my pain, my performance, or people's opinions—but by what God has spoken.

Many struggle with confidence not because they lack ability, but because life has tried to rename them. Trauma, rejection, loss, failure, and disappointment can slowly erode identity if left unchecked. GODfidence restores what has been shaken by replacing lies with truth.

How to Use This Booklet

This booklet was created as a tool—not something you rush through, but something you return to. There are no dates to follow and no assignments to complete. Simply open these pages whenever you need to be reminded of who God says you are.

Read the scriptures aloud. Speak the declarations over yourself. Return to the same page multiple times. GODfidence grows with repetition. Your mind will begin to believe what your mouth keeps speaking.

GODfidence begins when we agree with God.

I AM LOVED

I have loved thee with an everlasting love: therefore with lovingkindness have I drawn thee. (Jeremiah 31:3)

For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 8:38–39)

TRUTH

God's love for me did not begin with my obedience and will not end with my failure. His love is constant, unchanging, and secure. Nothing I do can make Him love me less—and nothing I do can make Him love me more.

THE LIE I REJECT

I am not defined by whether others love me.

DECLARATION

I am loved with an everlasting love.

I AM CHOSEN

Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you... (John 15:16)

According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love. (Ephesians 1:4)

TRUTH

I was not overlooked or selected by chance. God intentionally chose me before the world began, with purpose and destiny in mind. I am wanted.

THE LIE I REJECT

I am not a mistake or an afterthought.

DECLARATION

I am chosen by God on purpose and for a purpose.

I AM ACCEPTED

To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved. (Ephesians 1:6)

Wherefore receive ye one another, as Christ also received us to the glory of God. (Romans 15:7)

TRUTH

I do not need to earn approval or prove my worth to belong. In Christ, I am already fully accepted. There is no waiting period, no probation, no performance required.

THE LIE I REJECT

I am not rejected or disqualified.

DECLARATION

I am fully accepted in Christ exactly as I am.

I AM NOT CONDEMNED

*There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus...
(Romans 8:1)*

*Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen
again... (Romans 8:34)*

TRUTH

Condemnation no longer has authority over my life. Shame has no voice. Guilt has been removed. Grace has the final word, and Jesus silences every accuser.

THE LIE I REJECT

I am not defined by my past failures.

DECLARATION

I am free from all condemnation.

I AM FORGIVEN

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (1 John 1:9)

As far as the east is from the west, so far hath he removed our transgressions from us. (Psalm 103:12)

TRUTH

My past does not define my future. God's forgiveness is complete—not partial, not probational, not pending. When He forgives, He also removes the record. My slate is clean.

THE LIE I REJECT

I am not carrying yesterday's mistakes into today.

DECLARATION

I am completely forgiven and made new.

I AM A CHILD OF GOD

But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name. (John 1:12)

Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God... (1 John 3:1)

TRUTH

I am not an orphan, not a stranger, not a servant hoping for approval. I am God's own child—His son, His daughter. I have direct access to my Father and carry His name.

THE LIE I REJECT

I am not alone or abandoned.

DECLARATION

I am a beloved child of the Most High God.

I AM FEARFULLY AND WONDERFULLY MADE

I will praise thee; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made: marvellous are thy works; and that my soul knoweth right well. (Psalm 139:14)

For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works... (Ephesians 2:10)

TRUTH

I am not an accident or a mistake. God carefully and intentionally created me. Every detail—my personality, my gifts, my story—was designed with purpose. I am His masterpiece.

THE LIE I REJECT

I am not flawed beyond repair or without value.

DECLARATION

I am fearfully and wonderfully made by God.

I AM HIS WORKMANSHIP

For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them. (Ephesians 2:10)

Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ. (Philippians 1:6)

TRUTH

I am God's ongoing work of art, His craftsmanship. He is not finished with me yet. Every season, every struggle, every story is being woven into something beautiful. I am becoming.

THE LIE I REJECT

I am not stuck or beyond transformation.

DECLARATION

I am God's masterpiece in progress.

I AM COMPLETE IN HIM

*And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power.
(Colossians 2:10)*

*According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto
life and godliness... (2 Peter 1:3)*

TRUTH

I lack nothing essential. In Christ, I have everything I need for life and godliness. I am not incomplete, insufficient, or less than. I am whole in Him.

THE LIE I REJECT

I am not missing something I need to be okay.

DECLARATION

I am complete and whole in Christ.

I AM REDEEMED

In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace. (Ephesians 1:7)

Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things...but with the precious blood of Christ... (1 Peter 1:18–19)

TRUTH

I have been bought back, rescued, and restored. My past does not own me. My mistakes do not define me. I have been redeemed by the highest price—the blood of Jesus.

THE LIE I REJECT

I am not damaged goods or too far gone.

DECLARATION

I am redeemed by the blood of Jesus.

I AM FREE

If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed. (John 8:36)

Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage. (Galatians 5:1)

TRUTH

I am no longer bound by sin, shame, fear, or the opinions of others. The chains have been broken. The prison door is open. I can walk in the freedom Christ has given me.

THE LIE I REJECT

I am not trapped by my past or limited by others' expectations.

DECLARATION

I am free in Christ Jesus.

I AM MORE THAN A CONQUEROR

Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us. (Romans 8:37)

For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith. (1 John 5:4)

TRUTH

I am not barely surviving—I am victorious. Through Christ, I overcome every obstacle, every fear, every attack. I don't just win; I conquer with confidence because of His strength in me.

THE LIE I REJECT

I am not defeated or powerless.

DECLARATION

I am more than a conqueror through Christ.

I AM SEATED IN HEAVENLY PLACES

And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus. (Ephesians 2:6)

If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God. (Colossians 3:1)

TRUTH

My position is not determined by my circumstances but by Christ. I am seated with Him in victory, above every problem, every fear, every limitation. My perspective is from His throne.

THE LIE I REJECT

I am not beneath my circumstances or without authority.

DECLARATION

I am seated with Christ in heavenly places.

I AM THE RIGHTEOUSNESS OF GOD

For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him. (2 Corinthians 5:21)

But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness... (1 Corinthians 1:30)

TRUTH

I do not stand before God in my own goodness—I stand in Christ's. His righteousness has been credited to me. I am not guilty, not dirty, not unworthy. I am righteous in Him.

THE LIE I REJECT

I am not defined by my imperfections.

DECLARATION

I am the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus.

I AM AN AMBASSADOR FOR CHRIST

Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God. (2 Corinthians 5:20)

Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid. (Matthew 5:14)

TRUTH

I represent the King of Kings. My life carries His message, His authority, His presence. I am not insignificant or invisible. I am sent with purpose to reflect Christ to the world.

THE LIE I REJECT

I am not without purpose or influence.

DECLARATION

I am an ambassador for Christ and His kingdom.

I AM EQUIPPED

Now the God of peace...make you perfect in every good work to do his will, working in you that which is wellpleasing in his sight... (Hebrews 13:20–21)

And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work. (2 Corinthians 9:8)

TRUTH

God does not call me to something without equipping me for it. I have been given everything I need—grace, strength, wisdom, and resources—to walk in His will. I am prepared.

THE LIE I REJECT

I am not unqualified or unprepared.

DECLARATION

I am fully equipped for every good work God calls me to.

I AM STRENGTHENED

I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me. (Philippians 4:13)

That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man. (Ephesians 3:16)

TRUTH

My strength does not come from my own ability. When I am weak, He is strong. His power works best in my weakness. I can face anything because His strength is made perfect in me.

THE LIE I REJECT

I am not too weak or too tired to keep going.

DECLARATION

I am strengthened by the power of Christ in me.

I AM NEVER ALONE

For he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee. (Hebrews 13:5)

When thou passest through the waters, I will be with thee; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow thee... (Isaiah 43:2)

TRUTH

Even in the darkest valley, the loneliest night, the hardest trial—God is with me. He has promised never to leave or abandon me. I am accompanied, supported, and never truly alone.

THE LIE I REJECT

I am not isolated or forgotten.

DECLARATION

I am never alone—God is always with me.

I AM VICTORIOUS

But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. (1 Corinthians 15:57)

For the Lord your God is he that goeth with you, to fight for you against your enemies, to save you. (Deuteronomy 20:4)

TRUTH

The battle has already been won. I do not fight for victory—I fight from victory. Christ has already defeated every enemy. My triumph is secure because His is complete.

THE LIE I REJECT

I am not destined to fail or be defeated.

DECLARATION

I am victorious through Jesus Christ my Lord.

I AM BLESSED

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ. (Ephesians 1:3)

The Lord shall command the blessing upon thee in thy storehouses, and in all that thou settest thine hand unto... (Deuteronomy 28:8)

TRUTH

I am not cursed, unlucky, or forgotten. God has already blessed me with every spiritual blessing. Favor follows me. His goodness pursues me. I walk in divine blessing.

THE LIE I REJECT

I am not cursed or destined for failure.

DECLARATION

I am blessed with every spiritual blessing in Christ.
